Retiree address change requests may also be made in writing either mailed to 1407 S. Harrison, Suite 140, East Lansing, MI 48823 or emailed to benefitsinfo@hr.msu.edu. Because of identity theft issues, address changes are no longer taken over the telephone. Representatives at the Benefits Service Center, cannot positively identify callers. The on-line process has the advantage that the process is screened by the MSUNet ID and password security.
