Oral History - Adams Nina Silbergleit, Wharton Center house manager has been scheduled for an interview. The committee suggested questions.

Awards - Jenny Bond Nominations will be solicited in January. A letter soliciting nominations goes to 400 administrators. Nominating material will be on the web site.

Old Business. The remaining FEA lectures for the season will be presented to LENS as a program. The emeritus from another university has been added to email lists and has attended an FEA lecture. No official status for such individuals has been established, but they are welcome to participate in FEA activities.

New Business: Discussion raised the question of possible blocking of Windows XP machines to campus systems in April when Microsoft drops support for XP.

The committee considered a questionnaire from AROHE, the Association of Re3tirement Organizations in Higher Education, regarding their conference to be held in August 2014. No one indicated interest in attending the conference. Rainey indicated he would complete and return the questionnaire.
